








What do RIRs across the world share?


Welcome to the RIPE NCC LIR Portal

The LIR Portal lets you manage your registry data and make queries and updates. Features of the LIR Portal include:

- View and edit your LIR contact and address information
- View billing information
- View IP and AS resources
- Check the status of open tickets
- Register for the RIPE NCC General Meeting
- Request IPv4, IPv6 and AS Numbers
- Update certain attribute values in allocation objects

All information exchanged is encrypted to ensure security.

The RIPE NCC Member Update is a useful way to stay up-to-date with the latest RIPE and RIPE NCC developments, issues and policies.

RIPE Database: What is it for?

To keep contact information. Network operators know whom to contact should they encounter problems with the IP addresses and ASNs.

To register IP addresses and AS Numbers. This ensures that addresses are used only by one network.


To publish routing policies. Routing is made more secure.

To provide reverse delegation. This maps an IP address to a domain.

RESTful API

The RESTful API can only process one object at a time. If you want to process several objects simultaneously, you need to write a script on the client side to handle the list of objects and feed them.








What are allocations and assignments?

An allocation is a reserved block of address space. LIRs further distribute smaller blocks from the

allocation to the End Users.






An assignment is a block of addresses from an allocation that has been given a purpose or use in a network.



What are PA and PI?





Provider-Aggregatable


addresses are assigned from an LIR's allocation.

If an End User holding a PA assignment wants to change providers, they will need to return the PA assignment back to the LIR. They cannot bring the addresses with them.



What are PA and PI?





Provider-Independent


address space comes directly from the RIPE NCC and not from the LIR's PA allocations.

When an End User holding PI assignments wants to change providers, they can bring these addresses with them to a different provider.
